

Denis Wade Johnson & Johnson New Investigators Awards

These prestigious awards are presented at the Annual Scientific Meeting of ASCEPT at a symposium designed to showcase new investigators in clinical and experimental pharmacology and toxicology. Nominations of suitable new investigators must be made by a member of ASCEPT, who should ensure that the nominee is also a member of the Society. The application must contain a letter of support and up-to-date Curriculum Vitae of the nominee, and should be forwarded to ASCEPT secretariat at CLEMS, to ascept@clems.com.au **by July 30, 2010**. The guidelines are as follows:

Objectives:

The objectives of the Award and symposium are to recognise and highlight the research contributions of new investigators to the disciplines of Clinical and Experimental Pharmacology and Toxicology, and to provide a forum through which these contributions can be widely disseminated to ASCEPT.

Eligibility:

Nominees for the Award must be members of ASCEPT and would normally be expected to have completed not less than two years and not more than eight years in employment since obtaining their highest tertiary qualification. There is no age limit.

Award:

All applications will be judged by the ASCEPT Scientific Advisory Committee and by members of ASCEPT Council. The selected nominees will be invited to present the cutting edge of their science at the Annual Scientific Meeting, where they will also be presented with a certificate recognising their Award. They will also be offered support for some of their expenses to attend the meeting, and may be invited to submit a review on their topic for publication in *Clinical and Experimental Pharmacology and Physiology*.
