

ASCEPT Achievement Award 2023 Guidelines

- The nominee must have made substantial scientific or service contributions to Australasian Pharmacology, Clinical Pharmacology, Toxicology or Clinical Toxicology over a sustained period (i.e. >7 years)
- The nominee must have shown leadership in the advancement and promotion in one of the disciplines of Pharmacology, Clinical Pharmacology, Toxicology or Clinical Toxicology and must be a member of ASCEPT.
- Each nominee must be proposed by two ASCEPT members, with at least one from outside the nominee's institution.
- Previous winners are ineligible for a period of seven years after receiving the award.

Submission Details

- A one-page statement providing details of the relevant contributions the nominee has made to Pharmacology, Clinical Pharmacology, Toxicology or Clinical Toxicology, and outlying reasons why the nominee should receive this award.
- The nominee's CV.
- If appropriate, copies of up to four papers considered by the proposer or the nominee to be particularly significant contributions. Nominations may stand for three years.
- An indication that the nominee is willing to be nominated.
