

ASCEPT Tony Smith Quality Use of Medicines prize (oral prize)

Details of award	The ASCEPT Tony Smith Quality Use of Medicines (QUM) prize was established in memory of Emeritus Professor Anthony (“Tony”) Smith AM, a pioneering clinical pharmacologist and internationally recognised leader in QUM. It is awarded annually for the best research presentation on QUM at the Annual Scientific Meeting of ASCEPT.														
Eligibility criteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Financial member of ASCEPT. • Have not received this award in the previous 3 years. • Nominees would normally be expected to have completed not less than two years and not more than eight years in employment since obtaining their highest tertiary qualification, allowing for career disruptions, or be within 8 years of completing Basic Physician Training. There is no age limit. 														
Application	Applicants must submit an abstract for the ASCEPT ASM by the specified deadline and tick the box for consideration for the ASCEPT Tony Smith QUM prize for their submission.
