

ASCEPT Michael Rand Medal

<p>Details of award</p>	<p>The ASCEPT Michael Rand Medal was established in memory of Professor Michael Rand, a founding member of the Society and is awarded biennially to a member of ASCEPT whose research has made an outstanding contribution to the disciplines of clinical and experimental pharmacology or toxicology nationally and internationally. The award is made on the basis of the quality and impact of the candidate's published work.</p> <p>ASCEPT Michael Rand Medal is awarded every second year on odd numbered years.</p>
<p>Eligibility criteria</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Financial member of ASCEPT. • Nominees for the Award must have been ASCEPT members for at least the previous 2 years, or if a valid interruption to membership exists, have been a member of ASCEPT for at least 2 years prior to the suspension of membership. • Nominees for this medal are required to be nominated and seconded by two current ASCEPT members, with at least one from outside the nominee's institution. The Nominator must submit the application. • Have not received this award, or the ASCEPT Lecturer award, in the previous 7 years.
<p>Application</p>	<p>Applications must be submitted to the ASCEPT Executive Officer via email at ascept@ascept.org by the deadline.</p> <p>The application should include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A statement from the nominator/s providing details of the relevant contributions the nominee has made to clinical and experimental pharmacology or toxicology research nationally and internationally, including quality and impact of the candidate's published work. • The nominee's CV. • A statement of relative to opportunity, if relevant.
<p>Selection process</p>	<p>Applications will be assessed by an ASCEPT Board-appointed judging panel chaired by the President or a delegated member of the ASCEPT Executive.</p> <p>The judging panel will be assembled in accordance with the ASCEPT Equity, Diversity and Inclusion Policy and any real or perceived conflicts of interests will be declared and recorded.</p>
