

ASCEPT Achievement Award

Details of award	<p>The nominee must have made substantial scientific or service contributions to Australasian Pharmacology, Clinical Pharmacology, Toxicology or Clinical Toxicology over a sustained period (i.e. >7 years).</p> <p>The nominee must have shown leadership in the advancement and promotion in one of the disciplines of Pharmacology, Clinical Pharmacology, Toxicology or Clinical Toxicology.</p>								
Eligibility criteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Financial member of ASCEPT. • Nominees for the Award must have been ASCEPT members for at least the previous 2 years, or if a valid interruption to membership exists, have been a member of ASCEPT for at least 2 years prior to the suspension of membership. • Nominees for this award are required to be nominated and seconded by two current ASCEPT members, with at least one from outside the nominee's institution. The Nominator must submit the application. • Have not received this award in the previous 7 years. 								
Application	<p>Applications must be submitted to the ASCEPT Executive Officer via email at ascept@ascept.org by the deadline.</p> <p>The application should include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A statement from the nominator/s outlining details of the relevant contributions the nominee has made to Pharmacology, Clinical Pharmacology, Toxicology or Clinical Toxicology, and outlining reasons why the nominee should receive this award (maximum one page). • The nominee's CV. • If appropriate, copies of up to four papers considered by the proposer or the nominee to be particularly significant contributions. 								
Selection process	<p>Applications will be assessed by an ASCEPT Board-appointed judging panel chaired by the President or a delegated member of the ASCEPT Executive. The judging panel will be assembled in accordance with the ASCEPT Equity, Diversity and Inclusion Policy and any real or perceived conflicts of interests will be declared and recorded.
