

BPS-ASCEPT Outstanding Early Career Investigator Award

Details of award	<p>The Bellberry New Investigator awardees are also eligible for the British Pharmacological Society (BPS)/ASCEPT Outstanding Early Career Investigator Award.</p> <p>This prize will be awarded at the ASCEPT Annual Scientific Meeting and provides an opportunity for the awardee to spend up to 3 weeks visiting research laboratories in the UK and attend the BPS scientific meeting. The prize will include a return economy airfare to the UK arranged by ASCEPT. In addition, accommodation, contribution to subsistence and domestic travel will be provided by BPS.</p>

Selection process	<p>Bellberry New Investigator Awardees will present an oral presentation at the ASCEPT ASM. This presentation will be assessed by an ASCEPT Board-appointed judging panel chaired by the President or a delegated member of the ASCEPT Board. The judging panel will be comprised of the Bellberry New Investigator Award Panel and a representative from Bellberry. The judging panel will be assembled in accordance with the ASCEPT Equity, Diversity and Inclusion Policy and any real or perceived conflicts of interests will be declared and recorded. (The costs of travel to provide the presentation will be separately provided by Bellberry).</p> <p>Professional development opportunity:</p> <p>Bellberry will provide the Winner with the opportunity to observe a Bellberry Human Research Ethics Committee meeting alongside an established pharmacologist/toxicologist, for the purpose of learning and understanding more about the ethical and scientific review of human research projects (should this be of interest to the Winner).</p>
