

ASCEPT Achievement Award

<p>Details of award</p>	<p>The nominee must have made substantial scientific or service contributions to Australasian Pharmacology, Clinical Pharmacology, Toxicology or Clinical Toxicology over a sustained period (i.e. >7 years).</p> <p>The nominee must have shown leadership in the advancement and promotion in one of the disciplines of Pharmacology, Clinical Pharmacology, Toxicology or Clinical Toxicology.</p>
<p>Eligibility criteria</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Financial member of ASCEPT. • Applicants for the Award must have been ASCEPT members for at least the previous 2 years, or if a valid interruption to membership exists, have been a member of ASCEPT for at least 2 years prior to the suspension of membership. • Self-nominations are welcome. All applications must be supported by two brief (less than one page) referee reports by two current ASCEPT members, with at least one from outside the applicant's institution. • Have not received this award in the previous 7 years.
<p>Application</p>	<p>Applications must be submitted to the ASCEPT Executive Officer via email at ascept@ascept.org by the deadline.</p> <p>The application should include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A statement from the applicant outlining details of their relevant contributions to Pharmacology, Clinical Pharmacology, Toxicology or Clinical Toxicology, and outlining reasons why the applicant should receive this award (maximum one page). • The applicant's CV (maximum two pages). • Two written referee reports (maximum one page per referee). • If appropriate, copies of up to four papers the applicant deems to be particularly significant contributions.
<p>Selection process</p>	<p>Applications will be assessed by an ASCEPT Board-appointed judging panel chaired by the President or a delegated member of the ASCEPT Board. The judging panel will be assembled in accordance with the ASCEPT Equity, Diversity and Inclusion Policy and any real or perceived conflicts of interests will be declared and recorded.</p> <p>The application will be assessed according to the following criteria:</p>

	Quality and Impact of Contribution to Australasian Pharmacology, Clinical Pharmacology, Toxicology or Clinical Toxicology	70%
	Track Record relative to opportunity	30%
	Total	100%
	The award will be recognised at the World Congress of Basic and Clinical Pharmacology (WCP2026) in the ASCEPT Award Ceremony; however, the successful applicant will be notified prior to the WCP2026.	
Award	An official notification letter from the President will be sent to the successful candidate. The successful candidate will be invited to receive their award at WCP2026.
